A hate incident is...

- Any act or attempted act to cause...
- physical injury, emotional suffering, or property damage...
- through intimidation, harassment, force or threat of force, bigoted slurs or epithets...
- that is or appears to be motivated, in whole or in part, by hostility toward...
- a victim's real or perceived race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, disability, immigrant status, homelessness, or other physical or cultural characteristics.

What can you do to help...

- Stand up and value the diversity of all Marin County people representing religions, nationalities, cultures, and ethnic backgrounds, contributing to the richness of our community.
- Speak up if you hear or see hate violence incidents, hate speech, and acts of intolerance directed against a community member.
- Treat people as unique individuals.
- Be a positive role model for others.
- Teach your children to recognize and not tolerate discrimination.
- Point out bigotry, and discuss it.
- Have the courage to speak out against biased statements.
