YOUTH DRUG USE/ABUSE:

RECOGNITION AND PREVENTION

Evidence suggests that some students are experimenting with drugs and alcohol as early as the middle school years (grades 6th, 7th and 8th). Some students go beyond the experimental stage of substance use until they become dependent and addicted. The 16th District PTA, Marin County School/Law Enforcement Partnership and the Marin County Office of Education are offering Parent Teacher Associations (PTA) and Parent Clubs, the opportunity to have a drug prevention speakers panel at their school sites.

The panel would be comprised of a recovering student from Phoenix Academy, Marin's charter school serving students with substance abuse issues, that would provide information on their drug abuse story from experimental use to addiction and how they got clean and sober, a parent of a recovering student would review what it is like to have a substance abusing son/daughter and a representative from local law enforcement that would cover drug information and awareness issues. The speakers panel will be available for both evening and daytime presentations.
