

A DOZEN STUDENT RELEASE SCENARIOS

1. Parent A requests her child, who is in the student holding area.
2. Parent B requests his child, who has already been released.
3. Parent C requests two students, her child and another student whom she is authorized to pick up.
4. Parent D requests two students, her son and a student for whom she is not authorized to pick up.
5. Parent E requests his child, who is injured and has been taken to the First Aid Station.
6. Parent F requests her child, who is missing.
7. Parent G is extremely agitated, wants to bypass lines, get her child immediately and go home.
8. Relative H requests his nephew but is not authorized on the contact card.
9. Parent J requests his child, but the contact card lists a custody issue and a legal document on file.
10. Parent K does not have a photo ID but the secretary knows her.
11. Parent L fills out one student request for all three of her children, who are in different grades.
12. Parent M requests a neighbor's child, whom he is authorized to pick up, but the student is absent.
