

## **GROUP HOMES IN MARIN COUNTY**

**Sunny Hills Children's Garden**  
300 Sunny Hills Drive  
San Anselmo, CA 94960

A residential program providing education and community-based programs for abused neglected and emotionally disturbed children and adolescents. Provides a full spectrum of treatment services for children from infancy through age 18 and works to preserve and/or unify at-risk families. There are 7 group homes serving 6 youth each located throughout central and north Marin County. The main school campus and group home is able to serve 40 youth.

**St. Vincent's School for Boys**  
One St. Vincent Drive

A non-profit residential treatment center for troubled boys ages 7-17 who come from situations of severe physical, emotional and sexual abuse. Includes one level 14 house and 4 level 12 houses and serves over 60 boys a year.

**Nine Grove Lane**  
San Anselmo, CA 94960

Nine Grove Lane is a component of Huckleberry Youth Programs, an agency offering youth services in San Francisco and Marin Counties. This group home is the only 24-hour crisis shelter and counseling program for teens and their families in Marin County. In addition to crisis services, the program serves as the county shelter for abused and neglected adolescents and is the only 24-hour intake and assessment center where police and juvenile probation officers can access services for runaway and homeless Marin youth. Nine Grove Lane is licensed for 6 youth.

**Full Circle Programs**

Full Circle Marin is a residential treatment program and special education school serving boys ages 10-17, who suffer from severe emotional problems, behavior disorders and learning disabilities. A majority of the boys have been physically and sexually abused. Most have been abandoned or neglected and emotionally traumatized. The school campus and group homes are part of a supportive and close-knit West Marin community. Full Circle homes are licensed for 13 youth.

**Center Point Inc.**  
135 Paul Drive

Center Point operates a 22-bed facility offering residential care and treatment to adolescents between the ages of thirteen and eighteen. Adolescents are referred through county probation and/or social service departments throughout California with the majority of referrals from juvenile courts. The duration of care averages from nine to twelve months. Family reunification is a primary focus of the program.
