TITLE V, Part A

The Innovative Programs State Grants program provides districts with additional funding to support high quality, innovative educational programs. Funding can be used in a broad range of areas to improve academic achievement and the quality of education for students, to improve teacher quality, and to improve school performance. This entitlement program is funded through the district Consolidated Application. All previous uses of the funds under the former Title VI, are retained, with the addition of newly allowable funding possibilities: professional development, Title I supplemental services, public school choice, community services programs, consumer education, academic intervention programs, and service learning.
